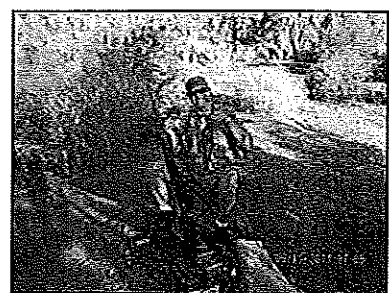
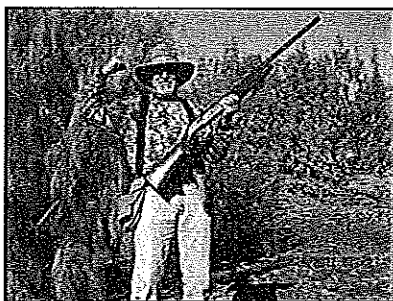
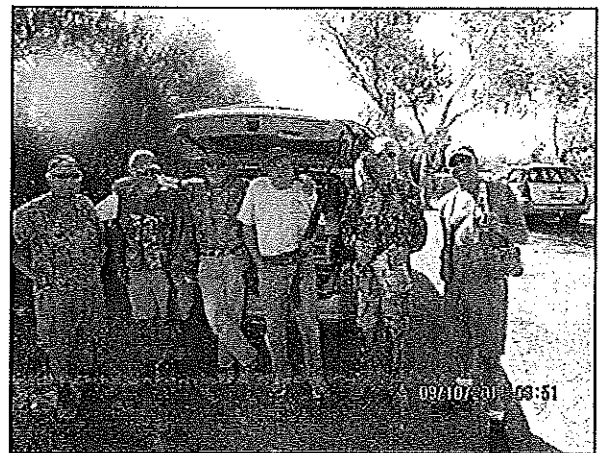
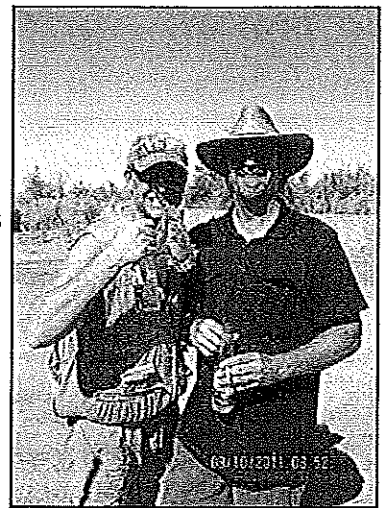
Yuma Dove Hunt

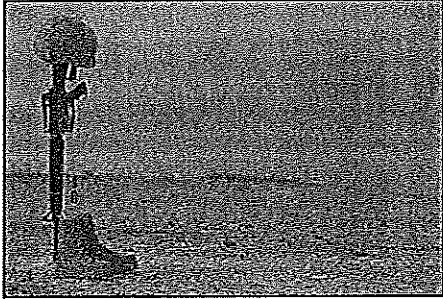


Searchlight Quail Hunt

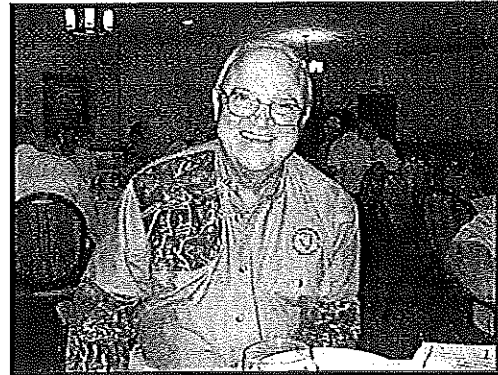
