When: Friday, Saturday & Sunday Oct 14, 15 & 16

Where: Near Searchlight, Nevada on Walking Box Ranch Road

Make it a day trip or come & dry camp with us. Bring an RV, Tent, Camper or sleep out under the stars. There are lots of birds this year, and a huge area to hunt them in.

Many natural springs & guzzlers are scattered all around the area and are accessible by dirt roads (4wd recommended). ATVs & UTVs will have a ball!

I'll be there before noon on Friday to start setting up. Bring your own gun, shells, food, drinks and some firewood if you can. Plan on having some great days hunting and some terrific nights sitting around the fire and lying about your adventures.

Directions: In Searchlight turn West on Hwy 164 toward Nipton, CA

In 7 miles turn left on Walking Box Ranch Road (Dirt Road)

Go approx. 7 miles to the Corral on right near mile marker 7 (We will camp in the corral)

## **Basic Defensive Pistol Craft Course**

### 8am - 4pm Saturday, Oct. 29th at the Education Center at Clark County Shooting Range

Our own in-club expert, Don Turner, is offering a rare opportunity for club members to get qualified training in defensive pistol techniques. The course will consist of an introduction to the modern technique of pistol craft consisting of dry fire and live fire training and practical exercises. This is not a tactical course so there will be no steel shooting, running or rolling around on the ground. We will do that in the advanced class. Each shooter will need:

- Gun belt with holster on strong hand side that is capable of drawing.
- NO cross draw holsters, inside pants holsters, ankle holsters, shoulder holsters, butt holsters or clip on holsters. <u>Strong</u> hand side belt mounted holsters only
- Semi auto handgun or revolver (that fits your holster)
- Three magazines or two speed loaders (that fits your handgun) and a pad or piece of carpet to drop empty mags or speed loader onto from standing position
- Mag pouches for two magazines or two speed loaders (that fits your magazines or speed loaders)
- Hat
- Safety Glasses
- Ear protection
- Note pad
- Pen/pencil
- 300 rounds of ammo (that fits your handgun)
- Band-Aids (to fit your fingers and thumbs)
- Sunscreen
- · Closed top shoes or boots, no flip flops, sandals, open top shoes, or bare feet
- Bag to put your spent brass in if you want to save it
- Staple gun and staples, or one roll of 1" masking tape
- Pistol cleaning kit (for your handgun)
- Cleaning rug, pad or towel to place on the table
- Folding lawn chair
- Sack lunch
- <u>Do not bring loaded handguns or ammo into the classroom.</u> All of the classroom exercises will be with unloaded firearms

Don is an AZ POST Certified Instructor for tactical rifle, tactical shotgun, tactical handgun (28 years), watercraft instructor, anti-terrorism instructor, hunter education instructor. He taught advanced and tactical firearms to game and fish officers for 28 years, taught at state police academy and at various other police agencies. He developed the departments two week officer survival program, and attended Gunsite Academy for basic and advanced pistol craft studies.

The course is \$25 for members but you MUST RSVP to Mike Taylor (245-2012 or mike@acnow.com) before Friday, October 28. Complimentary coffee & rolls will be served in the morning, and we recommend bringing a sack lunch. All training targets are also provided. See you there!

It was a beautiful morning and just a few clouds which helped keep the heat off our smiling faces as we were catching fish and having a great time.






After picture taking and cleaning fish, breakfast was at the Denny's inside the Fiesta Hotel for a little cool air and fish stories.
