The event is scheduled for January 30th 8am - 3pm on the ice at Cave Lake. Club members gather Friday night in Ely, the Rotary Club has an event with food, drinks and drawings for prizes at the convention center during the early sign up for the event 4;30-7:30pm. ## **Texas Turkey and Prarie Dog Hunt-Shoot**

Neil Dille is putting together a hunt. We will fly into Amarillo, TX. Rent a van and drive to a little town called Darrouzett, TX. close to the OK. border, about 3 hours. I checked Southwest Air, the tickets now are about \$198.00. So, if you stay 3 days, \$2,250.00 for the lodge and guides, air fare \$200.00 van about \$150.00 and tip. Turkey tag should be filled pretty fast and then hunt Prairie Dogs. Large Prarie Dog towns. The plan is: **A**rrive April 21, hunt 22,23,24, depart on 25 or Arrive April 28, hunt 29, 30, May 1, Depart on May 2

Just to give you an idea of what the hunt will be like, we will start early each morning before daylight chasing turkeys, usually till about mid morning. We will spend the middle part of the day setting up in a prairie dog town and shooting at dogs for a couple hours. Ranges for these shots can vary from 50yds to 400yds or further depending on your skill level/preference. We will squeeze lunch in there somewhere, then back out for an afternoon/evening turkey hunt.

As guys fill their turkey tags (1 tom turkey per hunter) those hunters will have more PD shooting time and/or pistol shooting at our pistol range and/or bass or trout fishing at a couple of farm ponds.

Let me know if you have further questions. Neil Dille 702 234-7215 or the guide Josh Robertson 405-570-7726 cell (Neil is trying to get one of these hunts donated for the banquet next month as well) Neil has hunted quail there the past 4 years, it is a first class hunt and lodge, meals are 100%. I was there in December seen about 200 turkeys, on third day had quail limit in 3 hours.
