December 15th Three Gun Shoot LAST MARKSMAN OF THE YEAR EVENT

Once a year we get to shoot a MACHINE GUN and this event is it. The format is shooting a semi-auto pistol, a semi-auto rifle and a **fully-auto machine gun, no bump stock, the real deal.** Those of you new to the club are in for a treat, regardless of the Marksman of the Year standings it is always fun to shoot something you don't get to do everyday. Often the machine gun has been the deciding factor in the final standings.....can you hold it on target to empty a full magazine? **NO SHORT BURSTS**. Honcho Dave Famiglietti from New Frontier Armory will be supplying the guns and ammo.



Details for the shoot will include 10 rounds with the Glock 19 9mm pistol, 10 rounds with the AR-15 semi-auto and 20-30 rounds with the MP5 full-auto. Dec 15th CCSC 100 yd range at the Training Center sign ups start at 8am shooting to start soon after. Cost will be \$25 including Lewis Class payout money



TURKEY SHOOT RESULTS



Honcho Don Turner put on another fun event. The format was simple enough, knock down the 5 steel turkey targets with as many shots as you wish (need) then you get only 10 shots at the paper turkey target which will count for your score. The targets were set at 50 yards and were special splatter targets with red (10 pts) in the "kill" zones of the head or spine and yellow (5 pts) for the other areas of the body. See the target. Don also established a 3 pt and 2 pt area near the head and neck. Some soon realized the small head shot target although worth the most points was also the hardest to hit with a good possibility of getting only 2 or 3 or even 0 points. So after the first line of shooters gave the others this insight many strategists elected to shoot at the lower left corner of the target, a much bigger zone for success. Getting 10 shots in the body would net you 50 points. A perfect score of 100 for 10 shots in the kill zone would be extremely difficult. As it turned out the HIGH score for the day was 52 by Larry Cussimano. Everyone enjoyed the format and the required skill as well as some strategy based on the targets.

Top shooters for Marksman of the Year points were Larry with 10 pts, Randy Peters 9, Mark Forsstrom 8, Brian Patterson & Mike Reese 6.5, Mike Lussier & Mike Taylor 4.5, Jeff Jorgenson 3 and the rest of the field of 23 shooters all got 1 point. Lewis Class money winners were Cussimano \$80, Peters \$50, Jorgenson \$80, Michael Reese, Fred Huntowski & Neil Dille each got \$15 in the second flight and Ken Johnson \$80 & Frank Mirabelli \$50 in the third flight.

Again a big thanks to Don Turner for setting up the shoot and ALWAYS changing the format to make it fun and exciting. This time we had 2 minutes to complete the shoot which was more than enough time but having that little clock ticking in the back of your head adds a bit of anxiety and may cause a few rushed or missed shots. Good job Don. The club supplied coffee and muffins as well. Don't miss the last shoot of the year the 3 Gun Shoot on December 15th at CCSC.


